

Guidance on the handling of complementary medicinal products in the notification procedure

From 23 September 2026, most **specialist data relating to complementary medicines in the notification procedure (KPTPO, Chapter 7¹)** – such as basic company dossier, master dossiers and individual notifications – will be available on the [Swissmedic Portal](#).

Applications will continue to be submitted by using forms and other documents submitted via the [eSubmission notification portal](#). For the time being, data relating to individual notifications will continue to be recorded in the HOMANT application and submitted via the eSubmission notification portal as before.

The guidance document [Authorisation for homeopathic and anthroposophic medicinal products and medicinal products for gemmotherapy without indication in the notification procedure](#), the [HOMANT Offline user manual](#) and other specification documents for the notification procedure therefore remain in force (see the [Swissmedic website](#)).

The **availability** of specialist data on the Swissmedic Portal can be used to obtain a quick overview of all basic company dossiers, master dossiers and individual notifications per marketing authorisation holder. Furthermore, the specialist data displayed can be helpful when submitting applications, for example to reconcile the specialist data for individual notifications newly entered in the HOMANT application with the specialist data already approved in the corresponding basic company dossier. However, the specialist data issued in writing remain authoritative and legally binding. From **January 2027**, it is planned that data for individual notifications will be submitted directly via the Swissmedic Portal (rather than via the HOMANT application, as has been the case to date). Further information on this will follow.
